### **Motor Vehicle Requirements**

Please also note that all motor vehicles including tractors must be registered or have a current permit.

**Indemnity insurance is available for unregistered tractors to enable them to be unloaded, moved on site, driven in designated areas and also to enter in the tractor balance.** The indemnity insurance is available at no cost to the exhibitor, but exhibitors **MUST** complete the relevant section of the entry form and provide the make, model and serial numbers of engine or chassis, year of manufacture. **Due to insurance restrictions unregistered tractors will not be able to take part in the Grand Parades.** Track type tractors will not be permitted on grassed area of the oval. Motor vehicles will not be able to be displayed in engine compounds unless they are used to drive exhibits.

### **Public Liability Insurance**

All persons entering compounds must have current appropriate insurance and be able to produce NHMA public liability insurance card or equivalent if required.

## Onsite Facilities

Unloading equipment (ramp, forklift and crane), engine water, Friday night and Saturday night security service and fencing are supplied to ensure that you have a "hassle free" weekend.

A free exhibitor camping area with showers and toilets will be available on site but it is the exhibitor's responsibility to provide all camping equipment, including tents. Powered camping sites are not available.

## Catering

On Saturday evening we will be offering a catered two course meal consisting of main course (choice of two meats) and sweets. Bookings must be made using the attached entry form. This meal is available to all exhibitors, families and officials. The price is \$18.00 per adult and \$9.00 per child. We look forward to your company at this informal evening. **No bookings will be taken at the event.**

Breakfast, consisting of fruit juice, tea or coffee, eggs and bacon will be available for purchase on Sunday morning from 7am to 10am **only**. A variety of hot and cold foods and beverages will be available during each day.

## Entries

There are two types of entry:

### Full Entry

Entry is arranged by completing the official entry form. **The entry fee is \$10.00 and this covers all the items that any one exhibitor brings along.**

Full entry includes an entry pass for the exhibitor and their partner, a complimentary rally pack with sponsor's products, one rally badge, souvenir programme, tea and coffee vouchers. **To be eligible for trophy judging, the exhibit must be on display for both days of the event and be listed in the event programme.**

Please forward your entry by 31<sup>st</sup> January 2010. This will ensure that details of your exhibit are listed in the souvenir program. Early entry also helps in the organisation of the weekend. **Entries received after 31<sup>st</sup> January may not appear in the Souvenir Program and therefore not judged.** An entry form is attached (add more pages if there is insufficient space for your entries).

### Casual Entry (vehicles only)

No entry form required. Just turn up with an applicable vehicle.

**The entry fee is \$5.** This includes entry for the driver and one passenger. A rally pack including a rally badge is not included. Rally badges will be available at an additional cost.

## Swap Meet

Sunday morning at 7:00am and this is your opportunity to buy or sell surplus items, machinery or parts. Experience is proving that this is a very popular event and there is always plenty of willing buyers. Exhibitors sites \$3. Non exhibitors sites \$10. Entry for exhibitor-buyers is free.

For security reasons there is **no entry** to the swapmeet area until 6:30am Sunday morning
