POWER OF THE PAST

Catastrophic Fire Danger Procedures

The following procedures will apply in the event of the declaration of a “Catastrophic Fire Danger” on any of the days involving Power of the Past (Friday, Saturday or Sunday).

1. If a Catastrophic Fire Danger is declared for the **Friday**:

Set-up activities will be CANCELLED for the day

Arrangements will be made for Exhibitors to set-up on Saturday morning

Public Admission will be delayed until after 2 pm on the Saturday.

2. If a Catastrophic Fire Danger is declared for the **Saturday**:

The event, including the dinner, will be cancelled for the Saturday

3. If Catastrophic Fire Danger is declared for the **Sunday**:

The event will be cancelled for the Sunday

Arrangements will be made for exhibitors who are unable to pack up and leave by Saturday evening to remain at the Showgrounds until Monday

If a Catastrophic Fire Danger is declared for the Friday, the Club Executive (President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer) may determine, based on current weather forecasts, that the event should be cancelled for the whole weekend.

It is possible that other circumstances (e.g. the requirement of the community to use the Showgrounds as a refuge centre) may require the Club Executive to cancel the event for other reasons.

Timing

Catastrophic (and other) Fire Danger declarations are generally made by the Bureau of Meteorology at around 5 pm on the day before the event (i.e. the declaration for Friday is made at about 5pm on Thursday)

Notification

Exhibitors will be notified of this policy and advised to monitor ABC radio and Hills Radio 88.9FM for fire danger information.

The Club Executive will endeavour to get ABC Radio and Hills Radio 88.9FM to announce any cancellation decision.
