THE GEOLOGICAL TRAIL – 2WD/4WD ok. Follow Brachina Gorge for outstanding record in rock of 640 million years of geological change in the Flinders Ranges.				
THE TWO GORGES – 4WD recommended. A fascinating drive through flora, fauna, historic and geological features of Flinders Ranges National Park.				
THE APPEALINNA STORY – 2WD/4WD ok. At the north of the Park we arrive at Appealinna to inspect outstanding ruins, a homestead west of the creek and a mine opposite on the eastern bank. Hear of the Wills family struggle with neighbouring miners.				
THE MAIL COACH RUN – 2WD/4WD ok. Trace the history of the Mail Coach between Wilpena and Blinman the roads to the Eating Houses, the coachmen and teamsters.				
ABORIGINAL ART TOUR – 2WD/4WD ok. Visit Dingly Dell, Perawirtina and Sacred Canyon where short walks lead to sites of aboriginal art. Hear stories about the Adnyamathana people.				
BRACHINA AND AROONA TOUR – 2WD/4WD ok. Drive through the beautiful Brachina Gorge enroute to Aroona, site of the Hayward pastoralist family in the mid 1800's. Hear about Hayward and his pioneering neighbours.				
INSIDE WILPENA POUND – 4WD/Walk. Past the locked gate the fire trail takes us to Hills Homestead inside the Pound. Hear the story of this pioneering family, inspect their home and machinery, walk to the nearby lookout for a panoramic view of the Pound.
