Sid and Joan resided in Second Street in the premises now occupied by Roger and Caroline Wyatt and their legacy remains in the club through Joan's sons Garry and Michael Bull who are members and sponsors of the club.




Formal Proceedings commence at 9.00am including the presentation of Australia Day Awards and a Citizenship Ceremony

RECIPE SPOT

ROAST VEGIE SALSA

SERVES 4 PREP 20 MINUTES COOK 30-35 MINUTES

- + Serve with whole roast fish or chicken.
- + To cook with roast, place dish on bottom shelf of oven for last 25 minutes of meat cooking time. While roast is resting, continue to cook vegetables for 10 minutes as recipe directs.

½ small butternut pumpkin, peeled, chopped

- 2 medium parsnips, peeled, chopped
- 1 large carrot, chopped
- 1 large beetroot, peeled, chopped
- 2 sprigs lemon thyme
- 1 tablespoon vegetable or olive oil
- 1/3 cup large green olives
- 1/4 cup chopped flat-leaf parsley



- 1. Preheat oven to 200°C/180°C fan forced. Line a large baking tray with baking paper.
- 2. Place vegetables, thyme and oil on prepare tray. Season. Toss well to combine and coat evenly, Bake for 30-35 minutes or until tender. Add olives and parsley to tray. Toss to combine. Serve. +
