Coonalpyn Community Hub is a not for profit Community Hub distributing 720 newsletters per month to remote rural areas and offering courses to re-engage a diverse range of people who would otherwise be isolated from these opportunities. CCH aims to get a diverse range of people to re-engage in adult learning through various types of activities. Some of the courses in the past have included First Aid, Boat license, Truck license, Forklift License, Yoga, Gardening, Cooking Classes, Wellness Reiki, Mosaics, Leadlighting, Ipad lessons, Bus Trips, Photography, Leisure Group and Easy Moving Active Ageing group. CCH has office space and rooms for hire and internet access for people to utilize.

CCH has a page in their monthly newsletter with “Hub Happenings” to inform the community of all of the courses they run. CCH also tries to source funding to run these courses to be able to make it less expensive for everyone to get involved. Volunteers work at CCH and they do a wonderful job.

CCH was the recipient of Adult Learners Week “Learning Community of the Year” award 2014.

The intended audience of the website and newsletter is diverse, ranging from adolescence to Seniors in a radius of 150km with seven towns and small remote communities.

A website and more professional newsletter would be of particular value to be able to advertise the courses and services CCH offers.
